- Smallest municipality in WI to have a public library, population of 263
- I've been the library director since 2016
- FTE staff 0.84
- Acquisitions Budget in 2023 was \$6,000, 2024 \$6500
- Total collection size 8,076 items

- Create List function in Sierra
- Continually evaluating items
 - Paging
 - Returns
 - Physical observation of the nonfiction collection

Weeding the Nonfiction Collection

Weeding the nonfiction collection

Weeding cart

- Weeding list
- Flags
- Library Director reviews the cart
- Items remain on cart until withdrawn

What happens to withdrawn material?

- Obsolete or misinformation recycled
- Poor condition recycled
- Donated for book sales



Delete items-any staff


Black out & stamp discarded-any staff



ABOUT RLPL


- 12 Sections double sided (3ft each)
- 3 Selectors
 - Non-Fiction, Large Print Non-Fiction, Audio Non-Fiction, DVD Non-Fiction
- Budget for Adult Non-Fiction is approximately \$12,000/year

EVALUATION & WEEDING

- Walking the Stacks
 - Monthly walk through (at least)
 - What's on the shelf too much/little, damaged or out of date items?
- Upcoming Programs
 - Materials to align with program topics
- Community Needs & Changes
 - Layoffs or closures can indicate a need for resources in specific topics
