SEARCH

Two ways to find materials from all MORE libraries!

Use the **MORE Online Catalog**

Use the **MORE Libraries App**



Enter a title, author, or topic in the search box.

REQUEST

Once you've found an item you'd like to check out, you can request it and it'll be put on hold for you.

1. Click the **Place a Hold** button next to the item in your search.
2. Select the most convenient library for pick-up.
3. Wait for notification that your item is ready for you to pick up and enjoy.

MANAGE

Log in to **My MORE** by using your:

- library card number or user name
- four-digit PIN

See your current check-outs, titles you have on hold, and other information about your library account.

Renew your materials up to two times unless there are holds. You can also call **1-866-MYRENEW** to renew items.

Pause your hold to receive your item later. You'll keep your place in line. Remove the pause to get your item.

Use the **Shelves** feature to save items for future reference.

Enable your **Reading History** to keep a list of items you've check out.

While logged in, view your fines, and **Pay Online** with Mastercard, VISA, or Discover.

Additional options are available with the **MORE Libraries App**. In addition to accessing your account info you can also add another card, and see open hours and directions to each MORE library.
